## Location

We are located in Troy, Ohio, 15 miles north of Dayton. From I-75 take Exit 74 (Main Street) east. Go 1.25 miles to Elm Street (Marathon Gas Station) turn left (North). We're about a half mile up the road on the right. There's a lane on the north side of the building that leads to the parking lot in the rear.

## Service Times

Our worship services are held every Sunday at 11AM. Arrive early for a cup of coffee and conversation in our foyer area. We also have Bible study & prayer on Tuesdays from 6-7PM, and a carry-in dinner immediately after the Sunday morning service on the last Sunday of the month.

You are welcome to park in the small paved parking area in the front on the church. There is additional parking at the rear of the church, which can be accessed via the gravel lane on the left side of the building.
