

Sermon Series: VII — The Last VII Letters
Message Title: SMYRNA: Persecution Coming

This morning we continue our journey into the Word of God focusing on Jesus' Last VII Letters to His Churches in Book of Revelation.

# The Book of Revelation has a 3-Part PURPOSE

- **P#1.** The letters to the **7 churches** (**chs. 2–3**) reveal that many of the congregations throughout Asia had **seriously strayed** from the original standards of **truth**, **faith** & **practice Jesus** and His disciples taught.
- P#2. In view of, opposition & persecution, Revelation was given to the churches to strengthen their faith, spiritual determination & loyalty to Jesus Christ. The Book is also aimed at inspiring Christians to be overcomers & to remain faithful to Christ, even to the point of death.
- **P#3.** Finally, it was written to provide Christians, of all generations, with **God's perspective** on:
  - (a) our fierce conflict with the forces of Satan
  - (b) our intense opposition from the world
  - (c) & the indisputable fulfillment of HIS PROMISES to the CHURCH!

The GOAL, of JESUS'S Letters, to SE7EN first-century churches was to challenge, encourage, warn & build up both believers & churches throughout church HISTORY, even to TODAY (Rev 2:7, 11, 17, 29; 3:6, 13, 22).

\*\*OUR GOAL with the VII SERIES, is to CHALLENGE, ENCOURAGE, WARN & BUILD UP, ABUNDANT LIFE!

<u>LAST WEEK</u> — Our Journey into the Word of God had us examine Jesus' 1st of, **VII LETTERS**, to the Churches in REVELATION. The **1st Church** we visited was **EPHESUS**. It was **commended** for everything it was **DOING** but **REBUKED** for ABANDONING their **1st LOVE**, **JESUS**!

When the WORK gets elevated over LOVE it is **worthless** because our Work must flow OUT of HIS LOVE!

1 CORINTHIANS 13 tells us we can HAVE & DO, all kinds of things, but without LOVE, We're nothing!

If we do LIFE without HIS LOVE, If we do MINISTRY without HIS LOVE,

or RELATIONSHIPS without HIS LOVE, even READ the WORD, or REBUKE the WICKED

without HIS LOVE...then its ALL a WASTE of TIME & WORTH NOTHING!!! (PS 127:1; GAL 4:11)

\*\*EVERYTHING MUST FLOW FROM HIS LOVE!!!

<u>THIS WEEK</u> — Our Journey takes us to **SMYRNA**, where we will explore Jesus' **2nd** LETTER to the **VII** Churches in REVELATION.

# General Info.

Just 35 miles North of *Ephesus*, the ancient city of *SMYRNA* today is the modern day city of *IZMIR*, Turkey.

**SMYRNA** was known for its gorgeous architecture & well-planned streets, one famous street named, "The Street of Gold," ran through the city. **Prosperity & beauty** were a source of great pride for its citizens.

**SMYRNA** was major center of *culture*, *art*, *& literature* in the ancient world. It was a major *port city*, & its *wealth* contributed to its reputation as a culturally sophisticated city.

# Political & Religious Info.

**Loyalty to Rome**: As a wealthy & important Roman port city, **SMYRNA** was known for its **intense loyalty** to Rome & was a **center for emperor worship**. Inhabitants were required to burn a pinch of incense to the Roman emperor and declare, "**Caesar is Lord**,". SMYRNA also had a renown temple to the Goddess Athena (War, Wisdom, & Handicraft)

<u>Hostile Jewish population</u>: The city was also home to a **significant Jewish community** who were actively slandering & persecuting Christians, but interestingly they received permission, because of their submission to Rome, to not have to participate in emperor worship. They were however very concerned the Christians would threaten/ruin this benefit for them.

## Biblically Significant Info.

<u>Meaning of name</u>: The name Smyrna is related to **myrrh**, a resin that gives off its sweetest perfume when crushed. Myrrh given as a gift to Jesus in celebration of His birth & used in His burial preparations.

At the time of John's writing, the city's nickname was *The "CROWN CITY"* because of its beautifully magnificent buildings situated on the slopes of Mount Pagos, which were said to *resemble a CROWN*.

**SMYRNA** was also know as a "CITY of RESURRECTION": it was founded as a Greek colony, destroyed in **600 BC**, and then famously "came to life again" after being rebuilt/resurrected centuries later.

\*\*It's history & it's nickname are symbolically echoed in Jesus's message to the church!

**HERMENEUTICS** (Theory & Method of Biblical Interpretation)

Historical Context (Who is involved & Why), Literary Context (Genre & Intention),

Syntactical & Verbal Specifics (the way words are put together & the specific words chosen),

Meaning (to the audience then), Significance (then, now, future).

On our journey, into the Word this morning, it is so important for us to carefully read each word of these 4 verses, so we can fully understand what Jesus said to SMYRNA and is still saying to us today.

Imagine yourself having gathered together with your family & other beleaguered believers in Smyrna. The once, lively crowd of Jesus followers, can't help but notice empty seats once occupied. Some left because of persecution, others arrested, exiled, or gone because they were "faithful unto death".

Most of you have risked your lives to gather, pray, study, & worship together. All are societal outcasts, deeply impoverished, troubled, afflicted, & distressed for the choice to live by faith in Jesus! Each one desperate for a word of encouragement from the guest who has brought a message to the church.

# As Pastor unrolls the scroll and begins to read:

### **REVELATION 2:8-11**

## To the angel of the church in SMYRNA:

8 "And to the angel of the church in Smyrna write: 'The words of the *first and the last*, who died and came to life. 9 "'I know your tribulation and your poverty (but you are rich) and the slander of those who say that they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan.

10 Do not fear what you are **about to suffer**. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be **tested**, and **for ten days** you will have **tribulation**. **Be faithful unto death**, and I will give you the **crown of life**. 11 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. The one who **conquers** will not be hurt by the **second death**.

Jesus' message is one of commendation & encouragement, no rebuke, & begins with the words, "I know."

Jesus knew personally the trials & tribulations being experienced by His beloved & precious church.

He understood the suffering, pain, & rejection they were enduring at the hands of sinners.

The word Jesus uses, "tribulation" includes, physical, economic, social, & religious persecution. The poverty they lived under was not just, being slightly underfunded, but rather a crushing, devastating, & inescapable poverty as the result of business being boycotted & deliberately suppressed by the Romans & Jews who hated them. The slander was disgusting & blasphemous from the Jews including slights of cannibalism, because of misunderstanding communion, & incest because they loved & called one another brothers & sisters in Christ. All this was intended to punish, marginalize & vilify Jesus' followers.

### **REVELATION 2:10-11**

10 Do not fear what you are *about to suffer*. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be *tested*, and *for ten days* you will have *tribulation*. *Be faithful unto death*, and I will give you the *crown of life*. 11 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. The one who *conquers* will not be hurt by the *second death*.

Jesus revealed there was *more persecution coming* & encouraged His precious church not to *fear* but to continue in their *faithfulness unto death*. For doing so, they would receive the *CROWN of LIFE*.

Do we have that kind of FAITH? To *faithfully endure*, to *trust God* with our lives, our families, & our death?

# Do you remember all the things we learned about SMYRNA at the beginning of this message?

- **SMYRNA** was called the "City of Resurrection" because it had been destroyed & rebuilt

  BUT Jesus IS the RESURRECTION & the LIFE & though we shall die, yet shall we LIVE, ETERNALLY
- **SMYRNA** was called the "**Crown City**" because its landscape & architecture resembled a crown. It's also because it was home to a world-renown stadium where victorious competitors received a champions crown. **BUT** Jesus gives those who are faithful unto death, a **CROWN of LIFE**!
- **SMYRNA** had MYRRH the resin that gives off its sweetest perfume when **crushed**.

**BUT** JESUS was gifted myrrh as a baby foreshadowing the crushing he would experience for our sins and then anointed with it for His burial just before His GLORIOUS RESURRECTION & ASCENSION!

#### **SMYRNA**

- REFUSED to abandoned their FIRST LOVE!
- TRUSTED God & were FAITHFUL to Christ even "Unto Death" (Search, Break, Send)
- Kept their EYES FOCUSED on the PROMISES of God (Resurrection & Crown of Life) & Valued them over the treasures of EARTH!

Perspective doesn't minimize, justify, or excuse the suffering, but it does allow us to **SEE HIM** through it!

Today is **Missions Sunday** — Lest we forget this mistreatment & tribulation is **STILL** being experienced by Christ's church, our brothers & sisters, of all ages today, I want to read a **true story** of **FAITHFULNESS!**
